Membership Information

VOTING MEMBER An individual must be enrolled as a member of a Northwest Tribe, who is also a practicing basket weaver, and current with NNABA membership dues. Each member shall be entitled to one (1) vote. All members have a right to actively belong to an existing NNABA committee. All members have the right to receive reports and vote on bylaw changes and the election of NNABA Board of Directors.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER Supports the work of the organization and does not vote or hold office. They are not enrolled members of Northwest Tribes. They may be Native American whose tribes are in other regions of the country or non-Natives.

Youth Track: On Friday 10/27/23, the youth will meet in a designated room along with their teachers to learn a basket project or two. Each youth must be registered by an adult who will provide their phone number so children may be picked up when they finish a their projects or by the session ending time.

There are two sessions, each youth should sign up for one or the other and not both sessions to enable all children an opportunity to participate. Session 1 is from 9-11:30 am and Sessions 2 is from 1 to 3:00 pm. The program allows local youth, member's children, and any other interested youth to learn basketry and hopefully become our future master weavers.

Please plan on staying with any young children because we don't have extra personnel to help supervise them; but if your children are 8 years old or older please plan on having them attend.

Chaperones escorting more than 3 youth must plan on remaining in the Youth Track room.

Please remember, no snacks, drinks, or phones are to be brought to the youth track teaching tables; students will need to use these items when they are done with their project.

NNABA is currently seeking funding to support the youth track program to continue having no charges of fees or kits for the youth but they will need to register their name, age, hometown and tribal affiliation as applicable.

Name Badges: All attendees will be issued a name badge, please wear your badge to identify you as a teacher or member in good standing (membership and registration paid). Please remember that you will not be allowed to weave or be in the weaving area without an issued name badge. Shopper passes will be issued to those who wish to join us but not weave on Saturday.

Members may bring their badge holder from a prior year to reuse/recycle; please do not bring extra badges to give back to NNABA because we can't reuse them. Let the registration table know you have your prior year badge and they will gladly remove your current name tag for you to put in you own holder. Thank you.

The gathering is a drug and alcohol free event.
